**Year 3:** PE Tuesday (Tiger only), Wednesday (Leopard only), Thursday (both classes); Swimming: Friday

**Year 4:** PE Tuesday (Kangaroo only), Thursday (both classes), Friday (Koala only); Swimming: Monday

**Year 5:** PE: Monday and Tuesday; Swimming: Thursday

**Year 6:** PE: Wednesday and Friday; Swimming: Tuesday
